UGA MENTOR PROGRAM QUICK CHAT GUIDE

This resource is designed to help you make the most of a Quick Chat with a mentor. A Quick Chat is an opportunity to spend time with a mentor in your career field of interest. They may also be useful in a graduate or professional school search as you seek to find the best program fit for your academic and professional goals. Quick Chats can help you to: build your network, explore potential career paths, tap into the hidden job market, and/or learn unpublished details about a specific company, organization, or school. Follow the guidelines below to ensure that you show respect for the time and energy put forth by the professional you contact.

PREPARATION

- Identify a mentor to contact in a career field of interest to you
- Research the mentor and their organization/industry
- Request a Quick Chat via the UGA Mentor Program (mentor.uga.edu)
- When arranging a Quick Chat, plan for the conversation to take 15-to-30 minutes or less
- Prepare for the Quick Chat using some of our sample questions
- Pay close attention to the time so that you can respect the professional's schedule

INITIAL MESSAGE TEMPLATE

SAMPLE QUESTIONS TO ASK DURING CHAT:

- 1. How did you get started in this field, and what educational background or experiences best prepared you for it?
- 2. What does a typical day in your role look like, and what are your main responsibilities?
- 3. What do you find most and least rewarding about your career, and would you choose this path again?
- 4. What is the typical career path in your field, and how do you see the role or industry evolving in the future (including growth, turnover, and advancement opportunities)?
- 5. What lifestyle considerations come with your role, including obligations outside of standard work hours?
- 6. How would you describe your work environment/company culture?
- 7. Where can I find job opportunities in this field, and are there organizations, resources, or contacts you recommend I explore further?
