
### YEAR IN REVIEW

UGA Mentor Program: FY '21 KPI vs. Current Status



Match Ratio Compared to Benchmarked Universities


Match Ratio = Number of participants (mentees & mentors) who have been matched / total # of participants that are eligible to be matched.

# PROGRAM IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS

## MENTEE GOAL ACHIEVEMENT

**97%** of mentees reported that they felt the University supported them in developing their personal and professional network with UGA alumni & friends.

**97%** of mentees reported gaining an appreciation for mentoring as a personal and professional development tool.

**94%** of mentees reported that the University provided them with an avenue to explore career interests and professional goals.

## MENTOR GOAL ACHIEVEMENT

**97%** of mentors agree that the University has provided them with a meaningful opportunity to connect with UGA students around life, career, and professional experiences.

**90%** of mentors agree that the University has inspired them to strengthen their relationship with and support of the University.






