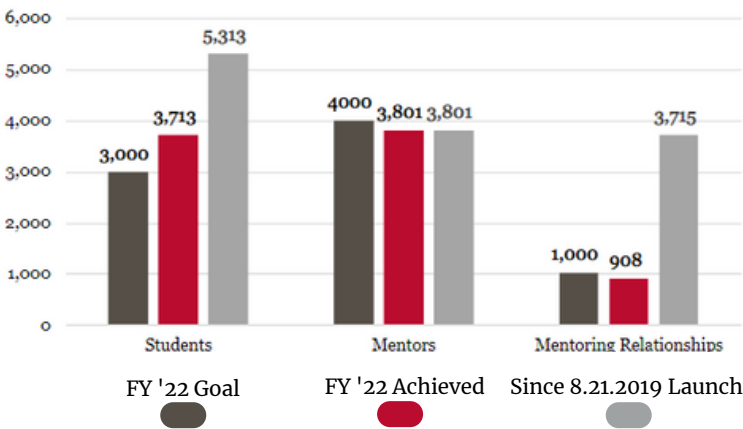

UGA Mentor Program: FY '22 KPI vs. Current Status

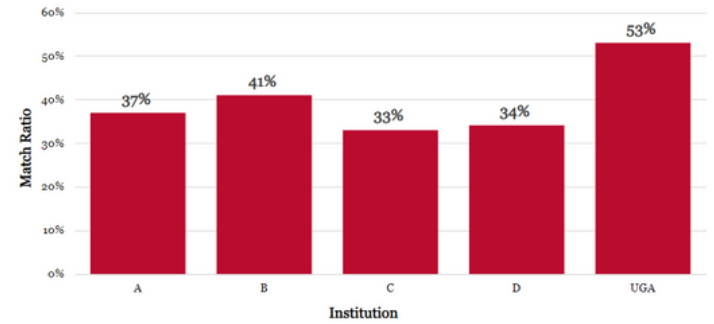

Match Ratio Compared to Benchmarked Universities

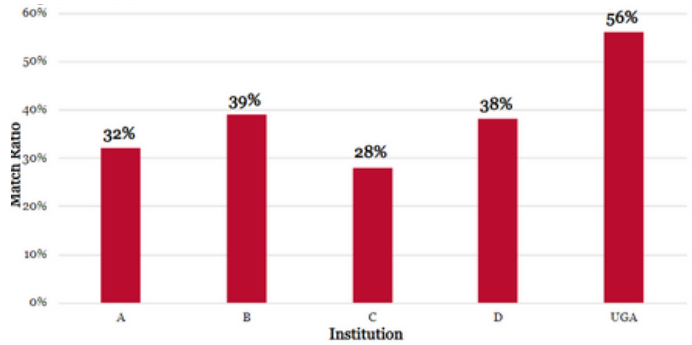
Match Ratio = Number of participants (mentees & mentors) who have been matched or made an informational interview connection / total # of participants that are eligible to be matched.

MENTEE GOAL ACHIEVEMENT

91%

of mentees reported that they felt the University supported them in developing their personal and professional network with UGA alumni & friends.

91%

of mentees reported gaining an appreciation for mentoring as a personal and professional development tool.

94%

of mentees reported that the University provided them with an avenue to explore career interests and professional goals.

MENTOR GOAL ACHIEVEMENT

91%

of mentors agree that the University has provided them with a meaningful opportunity to connect with UGA students around life, career, and professional experiences.

90%

of mentors agree that the University has inspired them to strengthen their relationship with and support of the University.

96%
