Choose a variety of questions from each of UGA's Core Competencies, write your own, and use the provided space to share constructive feedback with your mentee.

ABOUT THEM/ICEBREAKER QUESTIONS

- 1. Tell me about yourself.
- 2. What drew you to study [major]?
- 3. What does your ideal job/career look like?
- 4. What do you value in a workplace?

CRITICAL THINKING

- 5. How do you approach challenges?
- 6. Tell me about a time you faced a challenge. How did you resolve it and what did you learn?
- 7. Describe a time when you had to make a decision with incomplete information. How did you approach it, and what was the result?
- 8. Tell me about a situation where you identified a problem others had overlooked. How did you handle it?

ANALYTICAL THINKING

- 9. How do you approach learning new skills/softwares?
- 10. Tell me about a time you had to adapt to a new environment.
- 11. How do you organize and prioritize different projects or assignments?
- 12. Walk me through a complex problem you solved. How did you analyze the situation?

COMMUNICATION

- 13. How do you navigate differences of opinion in collaborative projects or discussions?
- 14. How do you respond to criticism or feedback?
- 15. How would you give feedback to peers?
- 16. Tell me about a time you had to resolve a conflict with another person. What was the conflict and how did you navigate the situation?
- 17. Tell me about a time when effective communication was critical to the success of your goal/project.
- 18. Give an example of a time when miscommunication caused a problem. How did you resolve it?
- 19. How do you integrate active learning into public speaking/presentations?

SOCIAL AWARENESS & RESPONSIBILITY

- 20. How do you approach collaboration with those who have different working styles?
- 21. How would you leverage the strengths of someone with a different skill set?

- 22. What does social mobility mean to you? How has this concept factored into your lived experiences?
- 23. Can you give an example of a time when you had to consider others' perspectives for a project/task?

CREATIVITY & INNOVATION

- 24. Tell me about a time you had to use your creative skills when making something.
- 25. Tell me about a time when you came up with a new approach or solution to a challenge. How was it received?
- 26. Have you ever identified an opportunity for improvement that no one else saw? What did you do?
- 27. Describe a time you had to think "outside the box" to solve a problem or complete a project.

LEADERSHIP & COLLABORATION

- 28. What is your leadership style? How would you describe yourself as a leader?
- 29. How would a supervisor or professor describe you? How would your peers describe you?
- 30. Describe a time when you had to lead a team through a difficult situation. What was your approach?
